This marks the first audit completion for Innolea, which joined ETS in 2022. The France-based company was formed in 2019 when the research activities in oilcrops genetics and genomics of the company Biogemma moved to a new company, Innolea, under the control of three major French seed companies in oil crops, LIDEA seeds, Limagrain, RAGT Semences, and the innovation fund for oil and protein crops, Sofiprotéol.
