GSG was honored with an invitation to speak to the <u>African</u> <u>Conference on Agricultural Technologies</u> (ACAT) in Rwanda. The event brought together experts, policymakers, and practitioners in the agriculture sector. Under the theme, "NextGen Ag-Tech Solutions for Africa's Farmers," the event explored key aspects of driving agricultural transformation through innovative Ag-Tech solutions tailored to the needs of African smallholder farmers. It focused on creating a supportive environment that fosters innovation by addressing critical factors including policy development, infrastructure enhancement, investment, and strengthening of market linkages. More than 700 people from 35 countries attended the conference.

Plant product stewardship plays a critical role in achieving these goals, and GSG took the opportunity to present the benefits of its programs towards these efforts.


GSG Seeks Program Committee Members


Have You Submitted Your Audit Plan?
